Shelby is applying for ALA grant focusing on library accessibility by senior citizens (increasing large print, audio, home delivery by book bike, grant is \$10,000 over 3 years, ties in with 2023 Big Read). Grant needs letters of support, such as Friends. OPL will pursue aspects even if it doesn't receive grant. Book Bike needs a logo; there will be contest for naming it. Barb asked if Community Conversations will continue. Shelby will be talking with new administrator; several new staff in village office.

Treasurer's report: Kathie will ask at PO about reduced box rental rate. Discussion about not needing a PO box. \$100 giveBig registration paid. Amazon Smile discontinued by Amazon; generous gift through Benevity. Motion Sherry/Quinn to accept with corrected report dates; passed. Yearly commitment to OPL: Motion Sherry/Miriam on suggestion to maintain our annual commitment of \$3,000; passed. Fees for MN residents using OPL: Motion to set aside \$500 for MN residents with financial need, Maureen/Carole, passed. Library board meetings: Miriam read Cheryl's Jan report; Miriam presented Dec report: Discussion of wages observed that library wages are still below Walmart's. Shelby said our attendance at meetings is appreciated by members, who are also glad to know where to donate their puzzles. \$500 Donation toward Book Bike appreciated.
